- Judgement was prophesied.
(Zech. 14:5, Matt. 16:27, 25:31, 1 Thess. 3:13, 2 Thess. 1:7)
- Judgement is right and good.

V. 17-19

- We ought to expect the presence of false teachers.
(Matt. 7:15-23, 24:11,14, Acts 20:29-30, 1 Tim. 4:1-3, 2 Tim. 3:1-9, 2 Pet. 2:1-3, 12-22, 1 John 2:18-23, 4:1-3)
- False teachers are spiritless.

Takeaways

- The ungodly have no place in God's kingdom.
- Knowing our enemies helps us to defeat them.
- Our expectation of false teachers ought to make us passionate about knowing God's Word.
